Mapping Colonialism: The work of De-Colonizer in Israel.

Eitan Bronstein presents the work of De-Colonizer which envisages a future of equal rights for all people living in Palestine-Israel.

De-Colonizer has produced a map marking the hundreds of Palestinian, Syrian and Jewish localities obliterated since the beginning of Zionist colonisation.

The map, "Colonialism in Destru(A)ction," also marks the Palestinian localities which are currently in danger of being destroyed by Israeli state authorities as they continue colonising, and it will be available to buy.



Eitan Bronstein worked for ten years as the coordinator of projects involving Jews and Arabs at the School for Peace at Neve Shalom – Wahat al-Salam.

In 2002 he founded the NGO Zochrot, which promotes awareness in Israel of the dispossession of the Palestinians.

In 2015 he co-founded De-Colonizer with Eleanore Merza Bronstein and is its current co-director.
